A BRIEF ON EACH SECTION - Paper Based: Listening: It has 4 parts and 40 questions in all. It lasts for 40 minutes including 10 minutes transfer time for the answers to the main answer sheet. Reading: Academic Module: It has 3 passages, 40 questions in all.

General Training Module: It has 3 sections, 40 questions in all.

Writing: Academic Module: It has 2 writing tasks. Task 1 is primarily Report Writing (explaining diagrams and charts). Essay on task 1 must not be less than 150 words. Students are advised to spend 20 minutes on this task. Task 2 is an Argumentative essay. Essay on task 2 must not be less than 250 words. Students are advised to spend 40 minutes on the same. In all, time allotted for writing is 1 hour.

General Training Module: It also has 2 writing tasks. Task 1 presents a Letter Prompt (formal or informal). Students must write at least 150 words for the same. Task 2 is same as that of Academic Module

Speaking: Speaking has 3 parts and lasts for 11-14 minutes. It is done on one-to-one basis with the student. This is usually done on another day. Part1: Examiner asks general questions to the student, which relates to his/her work, studies, hobbies etc. This part lasts between 4 and 5 minutes. Part2: The candidate is given a topic to speak, which is printed on a task card. Students have to speak for 1-2 minutes and are given one minute to think and write down some points. This part lasts between 3 and 4 minutes. Part3: The examiner will ask further questions which are mostly related to the part 2 topic. This part lasts between 4 and 5 minutes.

A BRIEF ON EACH SECTION - Computer Based: Listening (computer-delivered test): It has 4 sections and 40 questions. After the end of each part of the Listening test there will be some time to review the answers. At the end of the Listening test, there will be 2 minutes to check the answers. The timing of the Listening test is between 30 - 34 minutes. (All other sections are same as Paner Based Test)

Speaking Section - Speaking Test time can be selected on the same day of Reading. Writing and Listening test.

SCORING: IELTS is graded on a scale of 0 - 9, known as Band Scale, Generally, a score of at least 6 bands for UG & 6.5 bands for PG is required in each section. The result for Computer delivered is available in 3-5 working days & for paper delivered is available in 13 working days.

- Speaking & Writing (54-67 minutes):
- Speaking: It has 2 sections.
 - Speaking Section 1: It contains the personal introduction. This is an opportunity to give your selected institutions some information about yourself. This section is not scored.
 - Speaking Section 2: It contains read aloud, repeat sentence, describe image, retell lecture and answer short question.
- Writing: Summarize written text: You have 10 minutes to write the summary in one sentence. Make sure to include the main points of the reading passage in a full single sentence of no more than 75 words.
 - Write Essay: For this section, you need to write a 200-300 word argumentative essay in response to a prompt. You have 20 minutes to write your essay.

A BRIEF ON EACH SECTION

- Reading: Reading tests the candidates' ability to read and comprehend the passages, and answer the questions based on the same. It consists of 2 passages and each passage having 10 questions on it. It lasts for approximately 35 minutes.
- Listening: Listening tests the Candidates' ability to understand spoken English that is typical of interactions in an academic environment. It includes the talks and lectures of generally American speakers. There are 3 lectures comprising 6 questions each and 2 conversations comprising 5 questions each. The overall duration of the test is 36 minutes.
- Speaking: Speaking tests a candidate's ability to converse in English. Speaking has 4 questions prompts which include 1 independent speaking questions and 3 integrated speaking questions. TYPE OF QUESTIONS IN BRIEF

Read and Complete: You get a small paragraph with blanks, you need to type the missing letters to complete the text.

Read and Select: Words will appear on the screen, and you will need to indicate whether each word is a real English word by selecting 'Yes' or 'No'.

Write About the Photo: An image will appear on the screen & you need to write about it in 1-3 sentences. **Speak About the Photo:** An image will appear on the screen & you need to speak about it for 1 minute.

Listen and Type: You will hear a sentence & then you need to type it.

Read Aloud: A sentence will appear on the screen and you need to read it aloud.

Read, Then Speak: You get the question in verbal or written form and you need to speak about it for 1-2 minutes.

Interactive Writing: It involves a two-step process where you first write about a given topic for 5 minutes based on a prompt. Following this, you write a follow-up response for 3 minutes based on a second prompt related to your initial writing

Listen, Then Speak: You will listen to a prompt, and then speak your response.

Complete the sentences: It consists of a passage with several blank spaces, and you have to select a word from the options to complete the sentences.

Complete the passage: In this task, you will see two sections of a passage with a missing sentence in the middle and you have to select the best sentence to fill in the blank.

Highlight the answer: You will see a question on screen, and you need to find and highlight the answer within the passage.

Identify the Idea: You need to pick the main thought expressed in the passage from the given options.

Title the Passage: In this task, you need to select the best title for the passage from the given list of options.

Listen and Respond You will read about a situation, and you need to pick the best option to start the conversation.

Summarize the Conversation: You need to summarize the conversation concisely in the form of a paragraph, focusing on the key points within 75 seconds.

SCORING

Duolingo English Test is graded out of 160 in 5-point increments. The result is available in 2 days. Generally, 115 is considered to be a good score. Test results include an overall score as well as subscores of Literacy, Conversation, Comprehension, and Production. Were represents the test taker's ability to read and write; Comprehension represents the test taker's ability to read and listen; Conversation represents the test taker's ability to listen and speak; and Production represents the test taker's ability to write and speak.

The test result certificates includes "score range" which represents the standard error of measurement (SEM). The SEM represents a range of scores within which a test taker's true score lies. The overall score is not an average of the subscores. All five scores are estimated independently and are weighted combinations of the questions that contribute to the score.

What is IELTS UKVI?

IELTS for UKVI' is a UK government approved Secure English Language Test (SELT). This is the same test as a regular IELTS test but this test is video recorded for increased security and thus costs more. It may be mandatory depending on your institution needs.

Who can take IELTS UKVI and the procedure

This test is for test takers wishing to study at undergraduate or postgraduate levels and for those seeking professional registration in the UK

How is IELTS is different from IELTS UKVI

Exam pattern of both the exams are same, only UKVi is video recorded and sent to the visa office. UKVI registration fee is 17,250/- and, IELTS registration fees is 17,000/-.

Is Basic English Grammar included in Coaching?




