Germany officially is the Federal Republic of Germany, situated in Western & Central Europe with 16 States. The capital & largest city is Berlin. Germany is one of the most highly developed industrial nations in the world and, after the USA and Japan, has the world's third largest economy.



Entry requirements

UNDERGRADUATE:

13 years of Education is mandatory (12 + 1 year from University) If not then students can go via 1 year Foundation Course

Or

10 years Education +3 years Diploma IELTS - 6.0 overall or TOEFL - 80 points (IBT), Duolingo - 95 German Language B2 level

MASTERS:

15 & 16 years Education with 55 % IELTS - 6.5 overall or TOEFL - 85 points (iBT), PTE - 60, Duolingo -110 German language upto 200 hrs - A1 level - Optional GRE - Optional

MBA:

- Freshers MBA Accepted.
- 15 & 16 years of Education with Relevant Subjects
- IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL 85 points (iBT)
- Work Experience 2 3 years prefered
- Some MBA programs do not required GMAT nor work experience.





Scholarships

Scholarship for private Universities range from 10% to 30%.

Start Date

It is advisable to start planning for the studies in Germany one year in advance. Major intakes are Summer (March) having Application deadline of 15 january and Winter (October) having Application deadline of 15 July.

For Visa one need to show around Euro 11904 in Blocked Account. But actual expense will be Euro 350-400

Academic Evaluation Centre (APS)

The German Embassy and German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) have jointly set up an institution to check the authencity of Indian student's educational documents and issue an Authenticity Certificate. These APS Authencity Certificates are mandatory documents to be submitted for the German study visa application.

Work Permit & Permanent Residency

Students are allowed to work part time upto 20 hours a week Students can earn around 500-600 euro per month. Basically internships are part of the course & after completing graduation or masters, students are eligible for an 18 month job search visa. After getting a job in a relevant field one can extend stay upto 5 yrs on a work visa.

As per Blue Card Bill passed in August 2012, International students also have an option of expressing interest for permanent Residency.
